

THE HEART AND DIRECTIONS FOR THE CUBIT AND FABRIC:

The heart behind Pentecost 2020 is Unity!

And any time we can participate in something together that is fun, creative, expressive and has visual significance we build pictorial memories and relationships! Through relationship we have an opportunity to love one another.

Fun, Creative, Expressive:

In Biblical times A CUBIT / a measure, literally means a “cut” or something “cut off”. The ancient cubit was used in the building of Solomon’s Temple as well as mentioned in other scriptures, often as a measurement in structures.

FABRICS, formed by the weaving together of threads. Flags and banners have great significance in the Christian Church, their use would be unique to different Denominations. Colours often have a symbolic purpose and are used throughout the Word to bring understanding, and a visual picture, to prophecy and apocalyptic literature.

Our heart would be that using these two symbols it would reveal a picture of prophetic nature. That as each individual Church would cut and prepare a cubit painting it in a solid colour as well as preparing a fabric in a corresponding colour, that it would represent the heart of your Church. That your heart, gifting and personality would be represented in the colour you as a church family choose.

Visual Significance:

On the day of our gathering we would have one person from your congregation enter with others and one at a time lay your Cubit representing your Church, down at the foot of the Cross.

The Fabric will be carried in by children from different churches, laying it down as the palm branches were laid down before Jesus. This fabric will prepare the way for the Cross to be carried in.

Our prayer is that this would be a picture of our hearts, surrendering our individual differences to the true Authority of Jesus Christ, coming together as One Church Body with many unique members in obedience to:

John 13:34-35 (ESV) A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.

Cubit: is to be made of wood measuring 18 inches X18 inches X18 inches, sanded and painted in ONE solid colour of your choice.

Fabric: measuring 4 feet X 6 feet, light weight, in ONE solid color the same or another of your choice.

PLEASE SECURE A SMALL TAG WITH THE NAME AND CHURCH AFFILIATION ON WHO WILL CARRY THE CUBIT AND LAY DOWN THE FABRIC, TO BOTH THE CUBIT AND THE FABRIC SO THAT WE CAN IDENTIFY THE CORRECT ONES ON THE DAY OF PENTECOST 2020.
